One out of two children
under age five die



Fetching water during the rainy season...



...from marshes shared with animals



Gathering (mud) water in a drying marsh



Water holes
in the dry marsh



When the marsh completely dries
people travel in search of water



Deep open wells sometimes
reach rainwater reserves



Water is pulled up by donkeys...



...from depths of 300 feet
